Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse – Video Training

Teachers, social workers, psychologists, nurses, doctors, dentists, and many other professionals are required to report suspected child abuse. Now, a new video training series presents the physical, sexual, psychological, social, and legal aspects of child abuse and neglect. The studio-quality videos are suitable for professionals experienced in making reports on suspected child abuse, child protective and child welfare workers, and those without any previous training in the subject. The training uses resources developed by Douglas J. Besharov - professor at the Maryland School of Public Affairs, a child welfare attorney, and a nationally recognized child welfare expert.
