- What does research evidence suggest about:
 - Job readiness
 - Work experience
 - Vocational training

Assessments Needed to Triage

- SNAP population is diverse
- Service approach depends on participant's needs
- In-depth assessments can determine service path

Job Readiness Training: Building Nebraska Families

- Home visitors worked weekly with TANF recipients on life skills
- Study found large earnings impacts
- Considerations:
 - Works in urban areas?
 - Transfer from home to classroom?

Work Experience: Evidence Discouraging

- Variety of approaches (paid/unpaid; private/public)
- Subsidized jobs programs found to be effective in short-run only
- DHHS- and DOL-funded evaluations of subsidized jobs currently underway

Vocational Training: Can be Effective

- Clear evidence of increased earnings for disadvantaged workers
- Sector-based training is promising
 - Employers matter
 - Training developed in partnerships with employers found effective
